Sir,

The Aided A.M.C.C. school at Varadarajapuram was inspected for grant for 1922-23 by the Deputy Inspector of schools, on 10-10-22 and for 1923-24 on 29-9-23. But the school was reported to have been aided by the Kallar Special Officer and hence grants were not sanctioned on its behalf for both the years, by the Council.

Subsequently it was understood that out of two teachers in 1922-23 and three teachers in 1923-24, only one who has read up to VI Form was paid by the Kallar Special Officer, Rs.5/- per mensem from 1-10-21.

The Council, in its Resolution No.15 (18) dated 30-10-24 (copy enclosed) sanctioned a sum of Rs.60/- for 1922-23

and Rs.80/- for 1923-24 to the school in question.

I, therefore, have the honour to request that Government will be pleased to sanction the payment of the amounts to the school as the claims are over six months old.

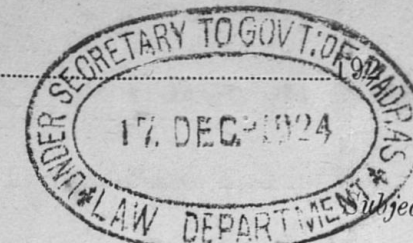

2. A school which has received aid from the Special Officer for Kallars has received aid from Government funds. The District Educational Council also dispenses aid from Government funds placed at its disposal. There is no good reason why Government aid should reach schools through two different channels. Reference in this connection is invited to para 3 of my endorsement R.C.No. 1662 B/24, dated 16th September 1924 containing my remarks on the letter of the District Educational Council, Madura proposing to pay -- Rs 10,000 to the Kallar Special Officer towards the cost

buildings and equipment for Kallar schools.

3. It may however, be open to the Kallar special officer to give additional aid to the school which have already received some aid from him. Alternatively it is open to Government to aid the school additionally by a direct grant to it and in that case the small amount necessary for the purpose can, if necessary, be found from the educational budget.

2. A draft order is submitted. It may be sent u.o. to Law (Genl) for acceptance.

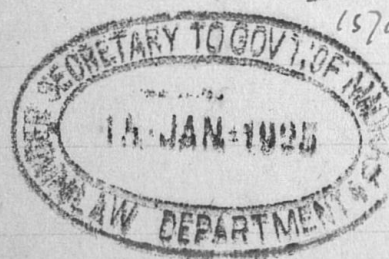
