In this connection it may be stated that untrained -- secondary grade teachers who were exempted from the provision of Article 3 of the Public Service Notification were permitted to draw Rs 45 per mensem, the minimum pay sanctioned for trained secondary grade teachers. Subsequently, however, it was thought unnecessary to permit these exempted teachers to draw Rs 45/- and accordingly ~~the~~ orders were issued on 11th April 1924 to all the officers concerned that such exempted teachers should draw only ~~at~~ the rate of pay sanctioned in G.O.No. 1577, Law (Education) dated 18th December 1922 for untrained teachers in Government Elementary schools. Hence the difference in the rates of pay drawn by the teacher from 11-4-1924 onwards.-- I have the honour therefore to request that the sanction of Government may be obtained for the exemption of Miss Kamala Bangaru from the provisions of article 3 of the Public Service Notification for the period of nine months and 10 days in the circumstances explained above.
