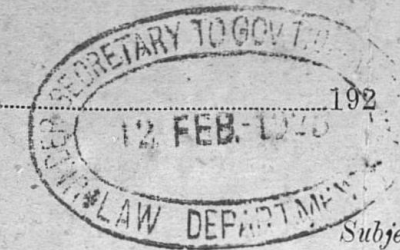

In the circumstances explained below, I have the honour to request that Government will be pleased to approve of the nominations of Mr. E.W. Green and Muhammad Abdul Huq Sahib Principal and Professor of Arabic respectively of the Government Muhammadan College, Madras to the Text Book Committee, Madras. According to rule 11 of the T.B.C. rules as modified in G.O.No. 546 Law (Education) department dated 11th April 1923, I have become the President of the Text Book Committee in the place of Mr. R. Littlehales on other duty, and in my place, as the nominated member of the Text Book Committee -
Vide G.O.No. 621 Law (Education) Department dated 23rd April

1924. I recommend that Mr. Green Principal of the Madras Muhammadan College may be appointed as a member.
