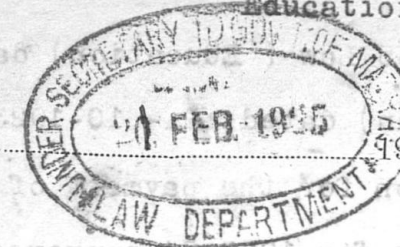

Sir.

P.Ramanjalu Naidu, a permanent clerk of this office on Rs.30/- is acting as a clerk in the South Arcot District Board Office on Rs.35-12-50 from 11-4-23. He was granted leave for a period of two months and 21 days from 25-6-1923 by the President District Board, but the clerk was not allowed any leave allowance from District Board funds as his acting appointment in the District Board service did not warrant payment of any leave allowance from that funds. As the clerk earned a privilege leave of 1 month and 29 days for his service of 1 year and 9 months and 21 days in this office (prior to his transfer to the District Board office) and as the C.S.R. and the Madras T.A.Rules have been made applicable to the establishment of the District Educational

(D) Councils in G.O.Nos.1335 Law (Education) dated 16-9-1921 and 1377 Law (Education) dated 7-10-1923 and as there was a specific provision for the payment of leave allowance in the budget for 1923-24 approved in G.O.No.1569 Law (Education) ^{Mis} dated 6-11-23, a leave allowance of Rs.57-4-8 (for the period from 25-6-1923 to 22-8-23) was paid to this clerk from the funds of the District Educational Council. But the District Inspector of L.F.Accounts in his audit notes for the period extending from April 23 to March 1924 (extract enclosed) has taken objection to the payment of the leave allowance and requires the specific sanction of P4CH Government for the said payment.

In these circumstances I have the honour to request that the Government may be pleased to sanction the payment of the leave allowance in question and accord general permission to the District Educational Councils to observe the Fundamental Rules also in the case of their establishments.

AUDIT NOTES.

On the Accounts of the District Educational Council, South Arcot for the period extending from April 23 to March 24.

3. Inadmissible payment - Grant of Privilege leave allowance to clerk:

Voucher No.504 dated 3-1-24 for Rs.57-4-8 being leave salary of clerk Mr. P.Ramanjulu Nayudu.

Mr. Ramanjulu Nayudu served as a clerk in the office of the District Educational Council from 20th June 1921 to 10th April 1923. From 11th April 1923 he was employed under the South Arcot District Board but retained a lien on his substantive appointment of a clerk in the office of the Dt. Educational Council. He was granted leave for a period of 2 months and 21 days from 25th June 1923 to 15th September 1923 by the President District Board South Arcot, who in communicating a copy of the order sanctioning the leave requested the President, of the Dt. Educational Council to pay the leave ~~leave~~ salary due to the clerk. He was considered to have earned a privilege leave of 1 month and 29 days for his service of 1 year 9 months and 21 days from 20-6-21 to 10-4-23 in the office of the Dt. Educational Council and a sum of Rs.57-4-8 (Rs.6/- for the period 25-6-23 to 30-6-23, Rs.30/- for July and Rs.21-4-8 for the period 1-8-23 to 22-8-23) was accordingly paid to the clerk from the funds of the Dt. Educational Council. The only authority pointed out for the payment of leave salary was the specific provision made for the purpose in the budget Estimate which was approved by Government in G.O.No.1569 Law(Education) Mis. dated 6-11-23. It was not stated under which rule or General orders of Government the clerk was allowed to serve the district Board retaining a lien on his post of a clerk in the office of the Educational Council and how the period of absence was to be treated. The rule under which the clerk was considered to have earned privilege leave and as to how the leave salary was regulated was not also quoted. In as much as no general orders in respect of the leave and leave allowances of the establishment under the Dt. Educational Councils having been issued by Government, it would appear that the specific

specific sanction of Government should be obtained in the matter.
 The fact of a charge which required special sanction having been included and passed in a budget is no authority for its payment.
 The sanction of Government may now be obtained or the amount of leave salary paid may be recovered.

The action of the President, District Educational Council, South Arcot, in having paid leave allowance to a clerk in the employ of the District Board was irregular. Submitted that the President may be asked to recover from the clerk the sum of Rs 57-4-8/- irregularly paid to him and to credit it to the funds of the District Educational Council.
