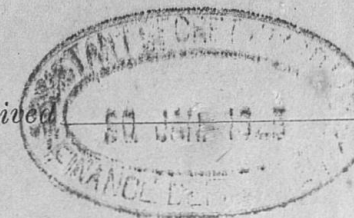

SIR,

I have the honour to invite a reference to the Government of India letter No. 27055 (A.D.) dated 20th May 1924 communicating the Secretary of State's sanction to the abandonment of the Provincialization scheme for the Lawrence Memorial School Ootacamund and to G.O. No. 879-Law (Education) dated 30-5-24 and to state that the provision of Rs. 2,20,000 and Rs. 17,000/- made under original works and Repairs respectively in the Provincial Budget should now be withdrawn. Works and repairs in connection with the school should be treated as Deposit works and the expenditure accounted for in accordance with the rules for such works.

2. As regards the expenditure incurred in the year 1921-22 to 1923-24 the transactions will have to be regularized. If the actual expenditure during these years is in excess or has fallen short of the contribution

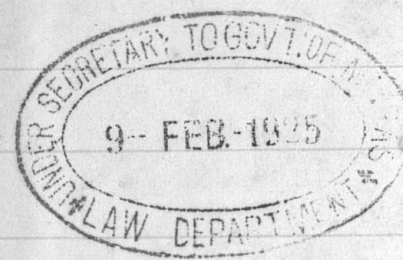

In G.O. 1697, D, 3.12.23, the
Govt. authorised the P.W.D. to carry
out the necessary repairs to the
school buildings of the Lawrence
Memorial school and the works in
connection with the school, pending
a final decision on the question of
provincialisation of the school.

The A.G. has sent the present
reference with reference to India's
letter of 20.5.24, communicating the
Secy. of State's sanction to the aban-

abandonment of the provincialisation scheme and to the transfer of the management of the school to a Board of Trustees. It is submitted that, though the trustee scheme has been generally sanctioned, ~~the detail of the scheme~~ ^(which) it has not yet been given effect to. ~~the scheme has not yet been given effect to~~. The matter has been the subject of correspondence between this Govt. and the Govt. of India and the latter has only recently advised as to the steps to be taken to give effect to the scheme. ~~the scheme has not yet been given effect to~~ [Vide copy of letter at flag (B)]

~~the orders of the court are required for the creation of the Board of Trustees and transfer to the Trustees will be given effect to only after these orders are obtained.~~

2. In these circumstances, it does not seem that any action should now be taken with reference to paragraph 1 of the A.G.'s letter. The orders in G.O. 1697 & 3.12.23 will hold good until the trustee scheme actually comes into force. It may be also mentioned here that, as the scheme is likely to come into force before the 1st April 1925, no provision has been entered

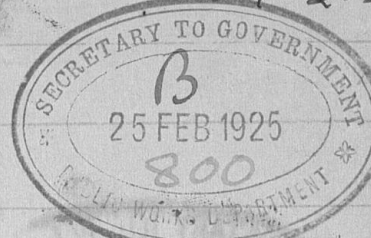
