Law (Edu) Dept

The applicant for exemption in this case is a clerk in the Settlement Dept. He wants exemption from examination rules in order to enable him to appear for special tests.

No special tests are prescribed for posts in the Settlement Dept. Apparently the clerk wants to qualify himself for employment in the Revenue Dept. The Board of Rev has the power to exempt candidates for employment in the lowest grade of the clerical service in the Revenue Dept. (Rs 35-60). If so exempted,

the clerk may also appear for special tests.

It is not clear why the Board has addressed Govt in the matter. Perhaps the Board is not prepared to certify that bona fide efforts were made without success to obtain passed candidates. This for orders etc.

2/ It is for orders whether in the circumstances the exemption applied for may be granted. The limit of pay upto which the clerk should be allowed to rise has not been specified by the Board.

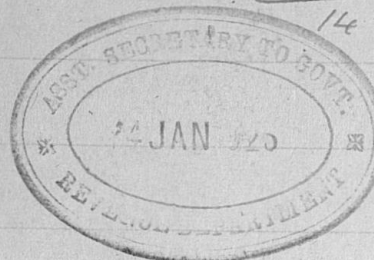

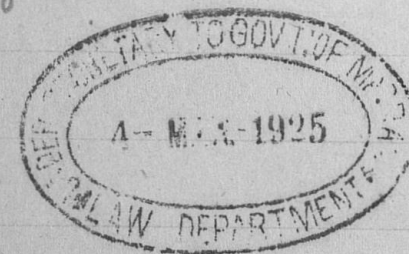
