On account of the outbreak of plague in the Salem Town, Government have, in their order No.901 Routine, Revenue, dated 9-12-24, sanctioned an advance of one month's pay to such of the Revenue subordinates and servants in the station as desire to evacuate their residences and engage field huts or construct temporary sheds. I have the honour to recommend that Government may be pleased to extend the concession to the subordinates of the Educational Department who are similarly circumstanced, subject to the conditions laid down in the G.O. in the case of Revenue Subordinates.

Substantive

Under article 154 of the Civil Account code, Vol I, the Government sanction the grant of an advance of one month's pay to such of the subordinates of the Educational Department in the Salem Town as are obliged to evacuate their houses on account of plague and are in need of help for living temporarily outside the infected area by either constructing sheds or renting houses. The advances should be recovered

in six equal monthly instalments.

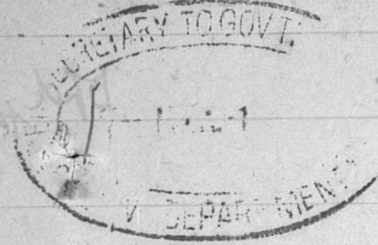
