I have the honour to invite a reference to rule 9(b) Fund iv of the Provident/rules contained in the Annexure to G.O.No.1651 Law Education dated 29-10-24 and to state that no reference has been made to procedure for the safe custody of cash certificates in the presidency town. 44 post office five year cash certificates have been forwarded to this office for safe-custody by the District Educational Officer, Madras and it is likely that an appreciably large number of such certificates will follow. I would, therefore, request that orders of Government may be communicated to me as to who should keep the certificates for safe custody in the Madras City.

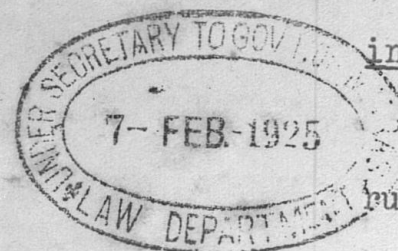

Rule 9 (b) (iv) of the Provident Fund rules
runs as follows:-

"The District Educational Officer or the
Inspectress on receipt of these certificates
will intimate to the correspondent the number
and denomination of certificates issued and
their date of issue and forward them to the
Treasury officer concerned for safe custody."

2. The A.G. enquires who should be deemed
to be the treasury officer for the custody of the
post office cash certificates in the Presidency town.
Submitted that this point was not considered when
the rules in G.O.No. 1651 (Education), dated 29-10-24,
were issued.
If the A.G. is not to be the custodian, perhaps the
Tahsildar of Madras may be considered to be the appro-
priate authority. The D.P.I. may be requested u.o. to
offer his views.

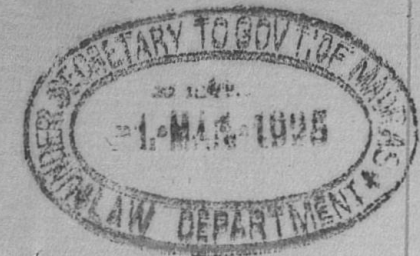
