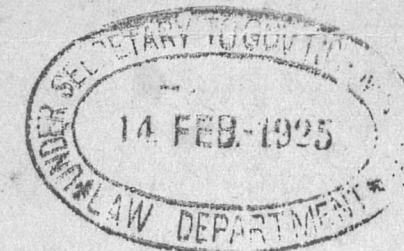

Sir,

The Committee constituted under section 20 (v) of the Madras Act VIII of 1920 for scrutiny of inspection -- reports of the Deputy Inspectors of schools for fixing -- teaching grants hold their sittings for a number of days -- and the members claim halting allowance for their stay -- during the period. G.O. No. 1647, Law (Education) Department, *dated 17-11-1921,* lays down that halting allowances are not admissible to members attending meetings of District Educational --- Councils and nothing is stated about the members attending sub-committees. I consider that atleast the members of -- this sub-committee should be allowed halting allowance, -- in view of the fact that they are necessarily to sit for a number of days to scrutinise the reports. I therefore

therefore request that Government may be pleased to allow the members to draw halting allowance and to fix the rate of --- allowance to be paid to them. If no facilities are shown -- to them in this matter, it is not likely that the members will care to spend money out of their own pockets, in addition to the inconvenience caused to them by way of sacrifices of their own personal business. Members attend a sitting and run away, so that at times we were obliged to adjourn the meeting owing to want of a quorum. Of course care will be taken that the total expenditure on account of travelling allowances is kept within the sanctioned allotment in the budget.

under G.O. no 498 Law (Edu) dated 21-4-1921 members attending meetings of Special Committee constituted under Section 20(V) of the Madras Elementary Education Act, 1920, are eligible for travelling allowance as for attendance at regular meetings of the Councils. No halting allowance is, however, admissible (vide

G.O. no 1647 Law (Edu), dated 17-11-1921). The President, D.S.C., Chingleput, requests that, at least, the members attending the meetings of the Special Subcommittees for fixing grants-in-aid to elementary schools may be paid halting allowance. It will be

seen from G.O. no 781 L + M, dated 28-3-22 that members of local boards are ineligible for halting allowance when they attend meetings of the boards. It does not appear desirable to allow to members of D.S.C. a concession denied to members of local boards. The remarks of A.S.G. may be invited (G.O.) in the matter.
