2. The petitioner acted as Sub-Inspector in this department from 1-1-24 to 3-12-24. He was discharged for want of vacancies. He has since been appointed as an acting Sub-Inspector.

3. The acting Sub-Inspector was granted temporary exemption from the examination rules for appointment as Sub-Inspector in acting, Sub protem and temporary vacancies. The petitioner has put in hardly one year's service. The Commissioner cannot recommend the permanent exemption unless he sees more of his work.

Further,

Further, permanent exemption is necessary only when the Sub-Inspector is confirmed. When the question of confirming him arises, the Commissioner will in the usual course recommend to Government, his permanent exemption from the provisions of Article 1 of Public Service Notification, if he is satisfied with his work.

Refering to G. G. No. ^(B) 97 of 24.1.25 on my petition dated the 22nd, December '24, I beg respectfully to submit the following few lines:

The Government of Madras have in the above-quoted G. G., regretted to comply with my request for exemption from examination rules in the absence of a recommendation from the head of a department willing to provide me with a post in the Government Service for which exemption from examination rules is required. May I have leave to say that The G. G., being susceptible of another interpretation stripped of its negative, comprehends that if any department is willing to provide me with a post, I shall be granted exemption.

I beg to state that I have been a Sub Inspector of Excise since January 1924, having had in November of 1923, addressed The Govt of Madras re: employment and been appointed a Sub Inspector on the recommendation and endorsement No. 9944-1, Public, dated 28. 11. 23, of The Govt of Madras to the Board of

Revenue who passed a resolution re: appointment in their proceedings D. No. 529 Routine of 23 dated 1. 12. 23. My original petition dated 22. 12. 24, was submitted in an interval of time between two successive appointments. Therefore it will appear that I have already been appointed and the question of willingness to provide does not arise. I have no permanent footing in the department. In order to stabilize my position in the department and with a view to establish a closer tie with the department, I beg that the Government may be pleased to grant me ~~the~~ exemption that is earnestly sought as else the duration of my acting period often ~~inter~~ interrupted will be prolonged. My appointment in the department is a sure indication of the willingness of the department to provide me with a post. I beg to remain,
