SIR,

With reference to G.O.No. 1038 (Law Education) dated 24-6-24, approving the Elementary Education Budget for 1924-1925, of this Taluk Board, with certain remarks, I have the honour to submit herewith a copy of T.B.R.No.115 dated 27-8-1924, for favour of information and to state as follows:-

In para (iii) of the above G.O. the Board was requested to consider whether the capital expenditure of Rs.9000/- cannot meet from loan funds, so as to make it available for the expansion of the Elementary Education. This question was fully discussed fully by the Board. This Board is fully devoting its attention to the Expansion of Elementary Education, ever since the Education tax was levied. For instance in 1923-1924, nearly 10 new schools were opened and in 24-25 12 new schools and additional teachers in 4 old schools have been sanctioned by the Board, which are to be started in a month or so, after obtaining District Educational Council's sanction. Hence, the Board, in addition to the expansion of the Elementary Education, wish to construct buildings in important and thriving centres of this Taluk, where buildings are quite essential, for which the sum of Rs.9,000/- was provided for. To go in for a loan was found to be unnecessary, as there is sufficient education fund at the disposal of

of the Board. Even in the Retrenchment Committee appointed in G.O.No.2043 L & M dated 17-9-1923, held in the Madura District Board Office on 15-2-1924, and in the Administration Report of the District Board for 1922-1923, it is said that the Taluk Boards are in a sound financial position.

In these circumstances, the figure provided for Capital Expenditure under Education, is allowed to be appropriated from Ordinary resources as provided for in the budget without applying for any loan.

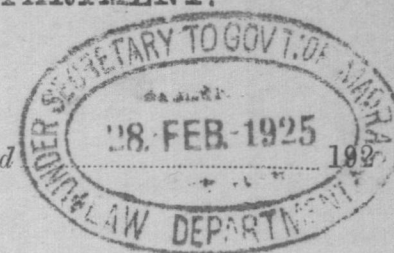

In resubmitting herewith the letter R.O.C.No.207 C/24 dated 11- 9- 24 from the President, Taluk Board, Melur referred to me for remarks in Government Endorsement No.3698 A-1 dated 9- 10- 24, I have the honour to state that it has been ascertained from the President that the proposed amount will be appropriated either from the proceeds of the Education cess or from the general balance available under the elementary education fund- It does not really matter how the expenditure is met so long as the proceeds of the cess and other receipts merge in one fund viz the Elementary Education fund.

All the villages with a population of 1000 and above in the area under the jurisdiction of the Taluk Board have already been provided with schools and there remains only 8 school-less villages with a population of 500 to 1000. It is observed that the Budget Estimate for 24- 25 of the elementary education fund under the boards control approved in G.O.No.1038 Law(Education) dated 24- 6- 24 closes with a large balance (Rs.22190), so that even after appropriating as proposed, a sum of Rs.9000,towards capital expenditure,there would still be a balance of Rs.13,190, which can be utilised for the expansion of elementary education. In view of this large balance and also in view of the fact that the board was not granted a subsidy towards the construction of school buildings in G.O.No.2014 Law(Education) dated 27- 12- 24, though it was prepared to bear one fourth of the estimated cost, I support the Boards proposal.
