I have the honour to state that in G.O.No. 785 Home (Education) dated 17th June 1918, the Head clerk of the Presidency College was permitted to accept a remuneration of Rs.60 per annum from the funds of the College Athletic Association for maintaining its accounts.

Now the Principal reports that the strength of the College which was 557 in 1918 has risen to 932 in 1924 and that the annual rate of athletic fees which was Rs.2 per head had been doubled since 1921. The work of the Head clerk has therefore increased and the Principal is

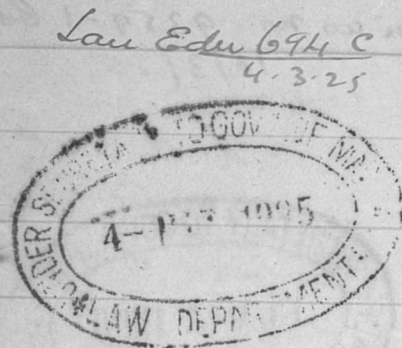
