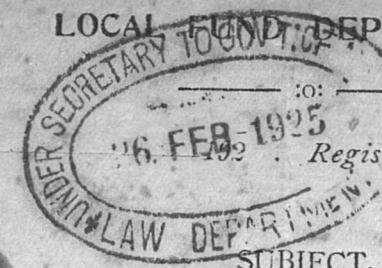

Sir,

I have the honour to solicit instructions of the Government as to whether the savings effected in the recurring subsidy granted by Government for the maintenance of new Elementary Schools in the current and in the coming year may be utilised for the construction of school buildings. The procedure may no doubt look objectionable in principles but still the necessity for accommodation in rural areas for location of Elementary schools accessible to all classes is such, that the Taluk Board cannot with their limited finances, undertake to construct a building of their own, nor are they in a position to secure decent buildings free from religious

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scruples for a reasonable rent. In fact the Taluk Board is at present incurring an enormous amount in the shape of House Rent -every year with no satisfaction either to the Taluk Board or to the Educational authorities as it is often remarked and pointed out to the Board, that the accomadation is either not sufficient and suitable or not free from objection. There are more than half a dozen places of this type where the Taluk Board is now paying exhorbitant rates of rent and where buildings of their own are quite necessary. They are Ettapur boys, Ganavalli Boys and girls, Kannankurichi Girls, Valapadi boys, Peddansaickampalayam and Thedavur boys. In view to avoid paying high rents every year and also to avoid congestion of pupils in the rented buildings which in most cases are not free from defects (sanitary principles,), I think the Board can well utilise the savings if any, effected in the recurring grants, made by Government every year, coupled with the surplus left in the Elementary Education fund towards the construction of the school buildings taken up gradually every year in the order of urgency. The District Educational Officer Salem with whom I consulted in the matter agrees with me. I would therefore request that the Government will be pleased to consider the above circumstances and to allow the concession applied for, which is nothing but in the interests of expansion of the Elementary Education among the depressed classes.
