(B) With reference to G.O.No.1540 Mis. Law (Education)
dated 3rd October 1924 in which a Building Grant not exceeding
Rs. 6250 is sanctioned towards the cost^{of} the building purchased for
the Wesleyan Mission Girls' School, Choolai, I have the honour to
request that the management may be exempted from the necessity of
executing the deed called for in paragraph 3 of the above G.O.

In making this request I wish to point out that the property has
been purchased in the name of the Wesleyan Methodist Missionary
Trust Association a Company Registered under the Indian Companies
Act VII of 1913 for the express purpose of standing possessed of
all the properties of the Wesleyan Methodist Missionary Society
in India. The Government annually makes considerable grants to
this Mission in Madras and elsewhere so that the Government can
at any time without difficulty recover out of grants payable to
the Society the whole or part of the grant sanctioned for the
above School, should the management fail to fulfil the
conditions on which the grant has been made. In this connection

I beg to call your attention to G.O.No.508 Mis. dated 7th April 1924 in which exemption is granted. I would also remind you that in your letter dated 29th October 1923 you exempted the late Rev.D.G.M.Leith from executing such a deed, the building in question being also a property of the above Trust Association. I would also venture to quote the Government Endorsement No.2584 A-1 dated 5th July 1924 exempting Miss Forbs of the Church of Scotland Mission from the execution of such a deed. I therefore request that you will be so good as to recommend the Government to exempt the above Trust Association from the obligation of executing a deed of mortgage. May I also request that immediate orders may be issued to the President, District Educational Council, Madras, sanctioning the payment of the grant without calling upon the management to execute the deed.
