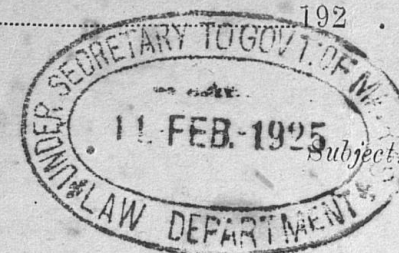

Queen Mary's College, Madras to the Director of Public Instruction

I have the honour to request you to view the orders passed
by Government regarding the pay and quarters for the post of
sergeant at this College and ask you to recommend me for free
quarters from the date of my entertainment as I find it very
difficult to pull along on the salary I am at present receiving
after deductions, viz. Rs 40/- I am required to be on duty both
during day and night.

Submitted and strongly recommended for favourable consi-
deration.

It is practically necessary for the Sergeant to live on the
premises if he is to be of any real use here.

Further I have saved Government Rs 11/- per month - the
wage of a 4th Watchman ~~is~~ having the Sergeant on the premises.

The pay with deduction for rent is very low for a good man -
such as is needed in this post.

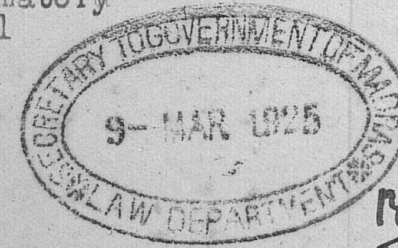

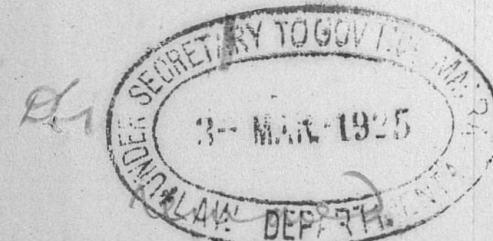
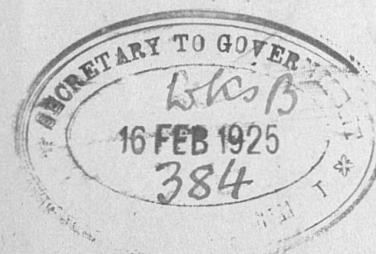
