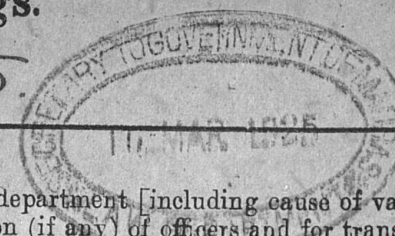

No. 1687, Law (Education), dated 3rd November 1924, and a temporary post in the Madras Educational Service has been created instead during the absence of Miss M.C.E. Karney on leave. This post of Inspectress of

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Girls' Schools in the Madras Educational Service is now held by Miss C. D'Souza, a permanent officer in the Subordinate Educational Service. As the vacancy in the Southern Circle was originally expected to last ^{too} ~~till~~ only 1st April 1925, Miss C. D'Souza was proposed for the place. But as Miss Karney is now proposed to be transferred to the Western Circle, it is desirable that the post of Inspectress of Girls' Schools, Southern Circle, should be filled by some senior officer who holds a substantive appointment already in the Madras Educational Service. Miss Schofield is a senior officer in the Madras Educational Service who has already been in the Inspection Branch as an Assistant Inspectress. She feels it as a grievance that she has not been appointed to officiate as an Inspectress, while some of her juniors have been so appointed and requests that she may be tried in the administrative branch as an Inspectress. I was in doubt whether I should recommend her for filling up an Inspectress' post in view of Mr. Littlehales' opinion regarding her ability and I therefore consulted him on the point. He states that he is also in doubt of her succeeding as an Inspectress but suggests that she may be given a trial. I am therefore proposing Miss E. Schofield as officiating Inspectress of Girls' Schools, Southern Circle, in the Madras Educational Service. If, however, her work is found unsatisfactory, other arrangements will be proposed.

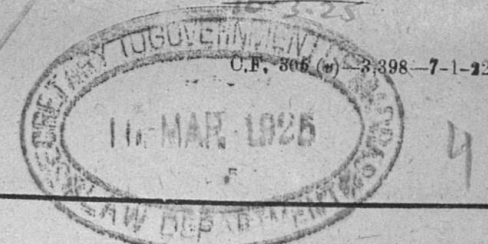
