In forwarding herewith the appeal of Mr. P. Jagannadhaswami of Parlakimedi, Member, District Educational Council, Ganjam, regarding T.A., I have the honour to state that the said member, Mr. P. Jagannathaswami and The District Educational Officer Ganjam, were asked on 8th if 17th January 1925 --- would suit them for attending the sub-committee -- to fix the teaching grants of Ely. schools. The appellant sent a reply stating that 17th was a --- convenient day for him and the reply of District Educational Officer was just then expected. But the District Educational Officer who was about to leave Parlakimedi on 9th January, suggested to the

appellant to send a telegram to President, District Educa- --
tional Council, Ganjam, saying that by arrangement with him --
[D.E.O.) the meeting may be held on 10th 11th etc. unless ----
the President telegraphs that it cannot be held the same day.
Accordingly Mr. P. Jagannathaswami wired to President thus
" Mr. Fyson (D.E.O.) suggests tenth and after subcommittee -
am arriving under his instruction tomorrow passenger unless
instructed otherwise immediately." The wire reached the --
office at 4-30 P.M. and by that time the member seems to have
already left his place very shortly after the office wired to
him thus:- " No time for intimation to members, suggest ----
another Saturday preferably seventeenth". Without receiving
this reply he came away to Berhampore on 10th when there was
no subcommittee meeting on the assurance of D.E.O.

He now claims T.A. for attending it basing it on the
strength of D.E.O.'s suggestion. I disallowed it as objection
able since there was no meeting. Hence appeal against my ---
orders. *vide order on p. 12*

So I request the Government may be pleased to ----
favour me with their opinion and advice regarding the claims
of T.A. on 10th to and fro.

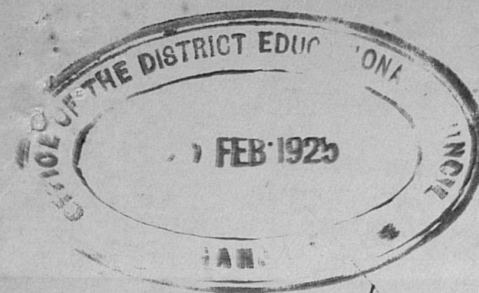
I have the honor to prefer to you an appeal against the decision of the President D.E.C. as embodied in his Dis No. 41 dated 16-2-25 enclosed hereto.

The President did not arrange the meeting for want of notice to the other members. But I did not go on any accord and I should not snub. I claimed T.A. which has been disallowed by the President.

Under these circumstances I pray that the Government may be pleased to sanction my T.A. this time even as a special case.

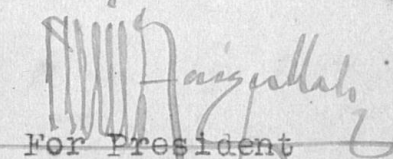
