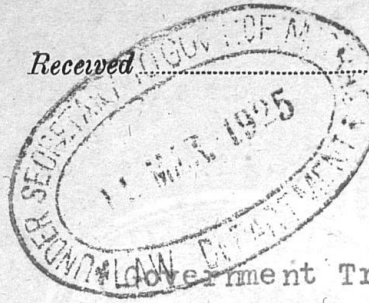

I have the honour to submit herewith a sketch plan of the Mint Building Compound wherein the Government Training School, Madras is located, marking therein the site condemned by the Director of Public Health and the present site.

'B' is the site condemned by the Director of Public Health and 'C' is the present latrine.

2. I choose the site at "A" with the idea of attempting a garden in the space west of it. But the Garrison Engineer selected the site at 'B' as he thought that a latrine at "A" would not only mar the symmetry of the open space but also be very near the model school.

3. As the terms of tenancy in the Mint buildings were of a nature of contract with a private body rather than of occupation of a public building, the Garrison Engineer acting as the agent to the landlord and as the site offered was conveniently situated so far as the school was concerned, no interference in this connection was anticipated from outside and the site was therefore accepted by me. Thus it will be seen that the Garrison Engineer is the officer responsible for the selection of the site.

4. In this connection I beg to state that the present site is by no means suitable and free from inconvenience. It is just below the dormitory and the boarders living in the dormitory are exposed to the bad odour coming from the latrine but they have to put up with it as there is no other alternative.

The plan submitted to Government does not indicate the latrine sites though the D.E.O. says that they are marked therein. It is perhaps unnecessary to return the plan and get the sites marked. The explanation may be recorded after perusal by Finance.
