Sir,

On behalf of the Southern India Brahma Samaj, Madras,
as the owner and manager of Maharajah Sir G.N. Gajapateerao
Bahadur Brahma Ragged school, I have the honour to submit
the following representation to the Government and to re-
quest a favourable consideration to it.

This samaj, a monotheistic religious body, with a
social and educational side, has been existing and working
in Madras for over half-a-century. One of the institutions
maintained by this body is a "Ragged school" for the children
of the poorer classes living in one of the densest-populated
parts of Madras—viz. the Kotwal and Chenga Bazaars. Begun
more than forty years ago, with a few boys, the school has
gone on increasing in numbers and usefulness. Favored with
the sympathy of several friends of education, the institution
has been enjoying the liberal patronage of the noble family
of the late Maharajah Sir G.N. Gajapati Rao Bahadur Garu. At
present the school is 190 strong. The need for ampler accom-
modation having become imperative, this samaj undertook to
extend a part of its buildings at a cost of several thousands.
Towards this work, the Madras District Educational Council
have been pleased to grant a sum of a little over Rs 2400. The
work has been executed, involving an expenditure much exceeding

double the grant given. Now this Samaj, as the Manager of the school, is required to execute a Deed of Mortgage under Rule 4 (ii) of Chapter II relating to grants for school and hostel buildings. I have stated above certain facts to show how this samaj, with its institutions, is a long-standing public body and to warrant the belief that its stability will continue for years to come. I understand that certain Christian Mission institutions—for example, the C.M.S. and the Wesleyan—have been exempted from the execution of similar mortgage-deeds on the ground of their being well-established, permanent institutions—a consideration which, it is submitted, this samaj, too, may well merit from its past history. Moreover, it will not be easy to separate clearly the portion properly liable to be mortgaged from the rest of the buildings; while the fact that there are other substantial portions of buildings in intimate association with the extensions under reference, and thus the whole property owned by the same body is much larger than the portion proposed to be safe-guarded by a mortgage, may be an additional reason for granting the exemption prayed for. Soliciting an early and favorable disposal,

The Southern India Brahma Samaj is a well organised and well managed Association. Its stability is in no way inferior to that of the Wesleyan Methodist Missionary Trust Association to which Government granted special exemption in G.O.No.392 Law(Education) dated 19th March 1925. I recommend the exemption sought for may be granted.
