Maternity leave is a special concession falling under Section VI headed "Exemption & Special Concessions" in Part IV of 7 Rs. It is granted on average pay (Subs Rule 1 under 7 R. 101) - Such leave is not

debited against the leave account. At present the two officers, viz D.P. I & S.G., to whom the powers to grant the leave have been delegated are heads of dep'ts (vide Sub: definition (ii) under F.R.-9) It is proposed to extend the delegation to the Inspectresses of girls schools, the Principal Lady Willingdon Training College and the Insps^{ts}, Pres^y Training School and Govt. & Govt. Secondary & Training schools subject to the three reservations mentioned in the

D.P. 2's letter (C4) in respect of ~~several~~ these heads

reservation is that the officers to whom

the delegation is asked ~~for~~ are not to make any ~~other~~ ^{officialing} arrangement in the place of the officer who is granted by them maternity leave. 9. The proposal is supported on the ground of certain delegations already made in the matter of appointments & leave. The grant of maternity leave is an exceptional measure. Only the D.P.D. & the S.G. are competent authorities. The cases likely to arise are not such as cannot be foreseen & no difficulty will arise, in practice, in restricting the powers to the D.P.D. & the S.G. No case has been made out for the proposed delegation, & if leave arrangements have to be made, in any case the matter must come before the D.P.D.

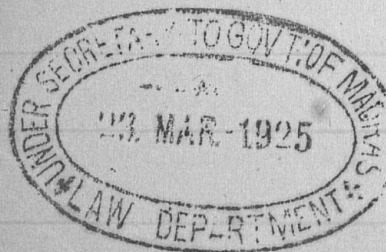
