S. Ayyadurai Ayyar, a permanent Board servant on Rs. 35 was entertained from 18-8-22 as temporary Physical Training Instructor, Government Training School Koilpatti on Rs. 30 which post was sanctioned in G.O. No. 799 Law (Education) dated 3-7-22. Latterly the pay of the post was revised into Rs. 25-1-50 with effect from 1-3-22 in G.O. No. 1063 Law (Education) dated 2-8-23. The Instructor however continued to draw pay at the old rate for a long time, without the Directors knowledge. Even when, on receipt of the G.O. No. 562 Mis Law (Education) dated 11-4-24, I called for a report from all the

District Educational Officers of cases affected by the G.O., the District Educational Officer concerned failed to bring the present case to my notice. This was found out only when I received a reference from the District Educational Officer about the date of increment of the Acting Instructor. I could not in these circumstances include the case in the statement annexed to my letter disposed of in G.O.No.67 Law(Education) dated 19- 1- 25.

I made a reference to the Accountant General enquiring whether the Instructor might be given on the authority of the above G.O.an initial pay of Rs.30 from 6- 10- 22, the case being similar to the case dealt with in para 2 of the G.O,the Instructor having been entertained in the old scale (Rs.30 from 18- 8- 22 ie prior to the date of the announcement by Government of revised scales for miscellaneous posts in the Department. The Accountant General has replied to say that the specific sanction of Government is necessary in order to give effect to my suggestion. Vide the copy of the Accountant General's letter No.Tin.1-731 dated 19- 2- 25.enclosed. In these circumstances I have the honour to request that I may be permitted to fix the initial pay of S.Ayyadurai Ayyar at Rs.30 from 6- 10- 22,ie with reference to the pay drawn by him on that date at the old rate.
