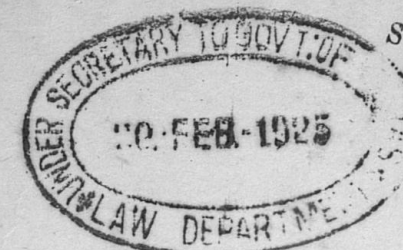

I consider that in cases in which ^{extensive} ~~extension~~ repairs are immediately required as a result of Cyclones or floods, grants should be admissible under Chapter II of the rules framed under Section 42(2) of the Madras Elementary Education Act, even though applications for grants are not received previously to the making of repairs, and I suggest that necessary provision may be included in the rules.

With regard to the second query, the President may be informed that the sanction of Government is not necessary for grants to be paid under Chapter IV of the rules framed under Section 42(2) of the Madras Elementary Education Act and that no deed is necessary in this case as the school becomes the property of the village, in immediate charge of the Village Munsif.

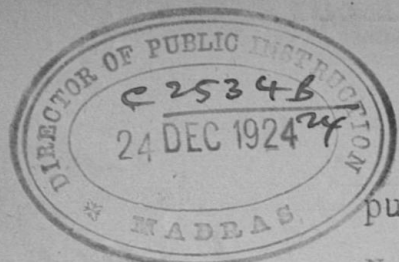

The rules under Chapter II of section 42(2) of the rules framed under the Madras Elementary Education Act of 1920, provide for payment of building grants to aided Elementary schools for any of the following purposes, (1) Purchasing, erecting or enlarging etc., etc., - - - and (2) Executing extensive alterations and repairs to buildings which have been newly purchased for school purposes. The rules are however silent as regards the payment of grants towards repairs to educational buildings which have already been erected or purchased.

Now certain applications have been received in the office requesting for a half grant towards the cost of repairs to old school buildings which have been considerably damaged by the floods and heavy rains during the months of July and August. Neither the rules framed under the Act nor any other G.O. issued from the department seem to cover this question. 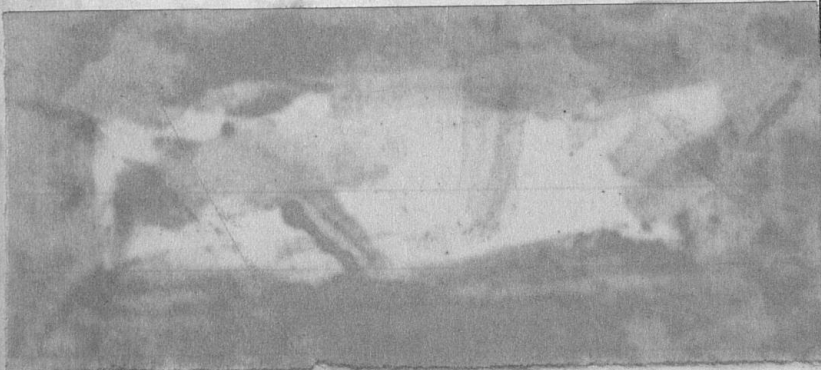

The existing rules provide for grants only in respect of initial capital expenditure. It is apparently the intention that the managements themselves should bear the recurring expenditure on maintenance and repairs. The proposed order will enable managements to claim grants towards "extensive repairs to school buildings damaged by cyclones, floods or other causes" and will throw additional expenditure on Provincial Revenues. It is for consideration whether the draft order may be accepted. If so, the words "other causes" occurring in the draft may be omitted as they are vague.

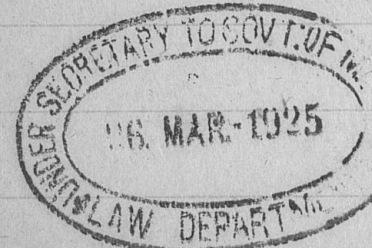
