With reference to G.O.No. 172 Law (Education) dated 5-2-1925, I have the honour to bring again to the notice of Government the fact that Miss V.E.Fearn, Woman Specialist in Physical Instruction is a young European lady who has to travel over the whole Presidency. It is most undesirable that she should be exposed to difficulties or unpleasantness of any kind in her travelling as may happen when the second class carriages are full, as is often the case.

2. I therefore request you will be so good as to move Government to reconsider their orders conveyed in the G.O. read above, and to treat Miss Fearn as an Officer of the III grade at least, allowing her to draw 1-3/5 first class

fares in respect of her railway journeys only.

Subject:-Miss V.E.Fearn--Grant of 1st class railway fares.

Miss Fearn was appointed as Woman Specialist in Physical Instruction from 6-1-22. In the agreement executed by her at the time of appointment, it ~~was provided~~ ^{was provided} that she shall, while on duty in India and during the period of her engagement, be entitled to such travelling allowances as are payable under the rules for the time being applicable to her case. In April of that year the D.P.I recommended that she should be treated as a 1st class officer for the purpose of t.a. The Govt.however did not accept the proposal ~~of the D.P.I~~ for the reason that the grant of ~~the~~ concession to Miss Fearn ~~will~~ ^{would} set up a bad precedent. -vide M.'s remarks on p.6 of G.O.No.742 dated 17-6-22.

The D.P.I again recommended in December last ~~that~~ ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ Miss Fearn should be granted a conveyance allowance of Rs.50 and 1st class railway fares. The Govt. saw no reason to ~~reconsider the order already passed and decline~~ to grant the request.

The D.P.I again renews his ~~request~~ ^{request} to grant Miss Fearn 1st class railway fares, ~~for the reasons~~ ~~mentioned here before~~ ~~for the grant of the~~ ~~concession.~~ ~~The proposal of the D.P.I may be~~ ~~reconsidered.~~

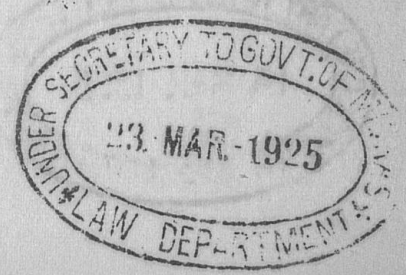
