Withdrawal of the orders excluding definite questions on wireless telegraphy from university examinations and tests.

Sir,

As a result of an interpellation in the Legislative Assembly the Government of India have considered the desirability of withdrawing the orders contained in the Department of Education

No. 445 - C.D., dated the 12th March 1913 (confidential). letters noted on the margin, which exclude definite questions on wireless telegraphy from

No. 1426, dated the 1st August 1913. university examinations and tests. These orders were issued in pursuance of the policy of refusing the grant of special licenses to educational institutions for the importation of wireless apparatus for class demonstration. In view of the changed conditions and of the facts that licenses to establish, maintain and work wireless apparatus are, for transmitting purposes, now granted to such institutions, subject to the concurrence of the local Government concerned, and that similar licenses for receiving purposes only can be obtained on demand at the principal head post offices in British India, the Government of India are of opinion that the orders are no longer operative and desire that they may be considered as cancelled.
