The Census Report does not furnish information as to ^{the} general literacy of the Nambudiris. It is believed, however, that the community is very backward in point of English Education. In response to a circular on the question of revising the list of backward classes appended to the Madras Educational Rules, the District Secondary Education Board, Malabar, has suggested inter alia that the Nambudiri community may be included in the list of backward classes.

2. In ^{the} addresses presented to Governors on several occasions it has been represented that, owing to their religious customs and habits, Nambudiri children are at a disadvantage in availing themselves of the education provided in the public schools and that a separate secondary school should be opened for them. The Government have ^{uniformly} ~~informally~~ taken up the position that the Nambudiris, constituting as they do a well-to-do class, should take ~~up~~ the initiative in the matter of starting a school and that, if they actually open a school, the Department will be ready to recognise and aid it under the rules. ^{Please see also the questions & answers in the linked file.}

3. The point of the resolution is that a committee should be appointed to suggest measures for promoting the spread of ^{modern} education among the Nambudiris. It is not clear why a committee is at all needed. The Nambudiris are ~~in affluent~~ in affluent circumstances. There are several other communities which are not only backward in point of education but ^{are} also in financial distress and it will be a difficult task if a committee should be asked for in each of those cases to consider the means of spreading education among them. ~~If the mover of the resolution will prepare a Memorandum on the subject and submit it to Government through the D.S.E., that ought to be sufficient.~~
