I have the honour to invite the attention of
Government to their order No. 532 Misc., Law (Education)
dated 9-4-24 stating that my proposal for the employment
of an additional Deputy Inspector of Schools (and esta-
blishment) in the South Arcot District should be held
over for 1925-26, and to request that Government will be
pleased to sanction the additional Deputy Inspector of
Schools with the necessary office establishment, with
effect from 1st April 1925.

The need for the additional post has already been explained in my letter R.C.No. 3284-C/23 dated 21-2-24.

Additional Deputy Inspector of Schools and establishment for the South Arcot District.

Proposals of the Director of Public Instruction.

In the scheme of reorganisation of the subordinate inspecting agency of the Educational Department sanctioned in 1922 the ~~no. of schools which~~ of a Deputy Inspector ~~was~~ was fixed at about 133. On this basis 12 Deputy Inspectors were allowed for the South Arcot District which had then 1,683 elementary schools. This gave an average of 140 schools to each of the Deputy Inspectors' ranges. Since then, the number of schools in the districts has increased to 164. Three of the Deputy Inspectors' ranges, as at present constituted, are unusually heavy and some of the places include unwholesome localities and are inconvenient for locomotion. The Deputy Inspectors concerned are consequently experiencing great difficulty in completing satisfactorily the inspection work assigned to them. The appointment of an additional Deputy Inspector in the district has thus become a matter of urgent necessity. Sanction is therefore requested for the employment of an additional Deputy Inspector with effect from 1st April 1925. The additional Deputy Inspector will have to be provided with the usual establishment. The extra expenditure, both immediate and ultimate, involved by the proposal is noted below:-

Note by the Law (Education) Department.

On administrative grounds the ~~proposed~~ employment of an additional Deputy Inspector in the district with the usual scale of establishment is ~~essential~~. With the additional officer, the average number of schools in the district will still be 140 against the ~~normal~~ normal no. of 133. The scheme was placed before the Finance Committee in March last and the Committee recommended its postponement for another year. The proposal to give effect to the scheme from the 1st April 1925 is recommended for acceptance..

A sum of Rs 2,336 or Rs 2,340 in round figures may be provided in the C. B. E. for 1925-26.
