Sir,

With reference to G. O. No. 600 Mis Law (Education) dated 15-4-24, I have the honour to resubmit for the sanction of Government the following proposal for the development of the Model School attached to the Government Training School for masters Dindigul into a complete Higher Elementary School by opening standard VI in 1925-26 and standards VII and VIII in the succeeding years.

2. For the reasons stated in my letter R.O.C. No. 1888-C/23 dated 26-9-23 disposed of in the G.O. referred to above the development of the model school into

into a complete Higher Elementary School is absolutely necessary. I therefore recommend that standard VI be opened in 1925-26. If that proves successful, standards VII and VIII may be opened in 1926-27 and 1927-28 respectively.

3. The proposal involves the employment of an additional teacher of the Secondary grade on Rs.35-60 per mensem in 1925-26 and of two more teachers of the same grade in 1926-27 and 1927-28 and I request that sanction may now be accorded to the employment of a teacher in 1925-26 with effect from 1-6-25. A further sum of Rs. 390/- will be required in 1925-26

in the Budget Estimate for 1925-26 to be submitted to Government shortly.

4. Provision for the additional expenditure required during 1926-27 and 1927-28 for staff, accommodation etc on account of the opening of standards VII and VIII in the school as estimated in my letter R.O.C.No.1888 C/23 dated 26-9-23 will be inserted in the Budget Estimate for those years.

Government Training School, Dindigul - Opening of higher standards in the model school.

The proposal to open higher standards in the model school attached to the Government Training School, Dindigul, was considered as a Part II scheme for 1924-25. The Finance Committee placed the scheme in class III i.e. as one that may be given effect to as soon as funds became available. No provision was made in the budget for the current year and the D.P.I. was asked to renew the proposal in time for consideration in connection with the budget for 1925-26.

2. The D.P.I. now proposes that a beginning to develop the school may be made from next year at least by opening standard VI in June 1925, and that if it proves successful, standards VII and VIII may be added to later on. The necessity for opening the additional standards has already been explained in the Director's previous letter - para 2 at pp 1 & 2 of G.O. 600 (Education), dated 15-4-24.

3. The expenditure involved in the next year is Rs 705 calculated as follows:-

(1) Employment of a second ^{ary} grade teacher on Rs 35-60 for nine months from 1st June 1925	Rs 315

before the Finance Committee as a Part II Scheme for 1925-26 and Law may be requested to prepare the necessary note for the Committee.



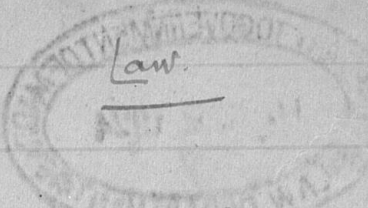

Note for the Finance Committee.

Subject: - Opening of higher standards in the Model school attached to the Government Training School, Dindigul.

Proposals of the D.P.I.

The training school at Dindigul is of the secondary grade; ~~and~~ the model section attached to it consists of only standards I to V. The secondary grade students under training have ~~to~~ to go without teaching practice in the higher standards, though most, if not all, of them will be employed later as teachers of these classes or classes of the corresponding grade. To supply this deficiency, the District Educational Officer, Madurai, urges the necessity for opening standards VI to VIII in the model school. ~~The D.P.I. considers that it would be sufficient to open standards VI to VIII if the school is developed gradually.~~ It is accordingly proposed that standard VI be opened in 1925-26 ~~and~~ ^{to open} if ~~it~~ ^{this} proves successful, standards VII and VIII may be opened in 1926-27 and 1927-28 respectively.

The proposal involves the employment of an additional teacher of the secondary grade on Rs. 35-60 a month in 1925-26 and of ~~an addl. teacher~~ ^{each of} ~~the~~ ^{two} ~~successive~~ ^{years} of the same grade in the two successive years.

For the higher standards proposed to be opened additional accommodation is necessary, and it is proposed to construct two temporary sheds at a cost of Rs. 1,500. ~~It is possible to manage without Additional accommodation in 1925-26.~~ ^{is not required} The temporary sheds ~~may~~ ^{will} be erected in 1926-27.
