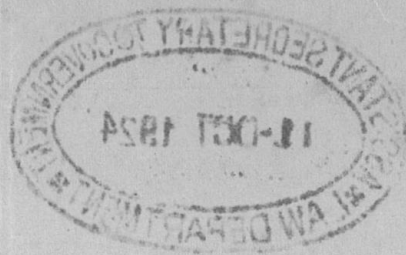

Mr. P. K. Pillai entered this College in October 1922, having already obtained the degree of M. A. in Madras University. He took the advanced course in Physics and Mathematics during the session 1922 -23, and tied for the first place in the final examination in June 1923, a distinction which no Indian student has hitherto approached.

During the following session 1923 - 24, he was engaged in further advanced study on the characteristics of thermionic valves, and on the subject of thermal emissivity from hot wires, for which he was awarded the Diploma of the Imperial College in July 1924.

In my opinion Mr. Pillai should be exceptionally well equipped for a teaching post of University rank in advanced Physics or Mathematics, or for scientific research in an industrial post.

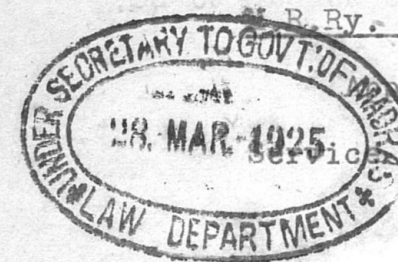

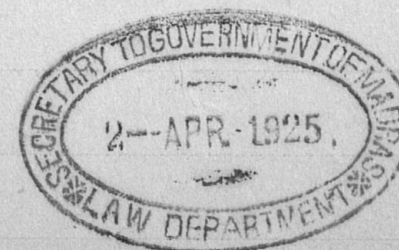
