Letter from Mr. R. Gopala Ayyar, Assistant Professor of Zoology, Presidency ^{College}, through the Principal, Presidency College, to the Director of Public Instruction, Madras dated 19th February 1925.

With reference to your P roceedings R.O .C.N o. 232 D/25 dated the 13th instant, I beg to furnish the following information. I live in Lloyd's Road very near the place where it joins the Mount Road. I have generally to go to the Victoria Hostel both in the morning and the evening. In the morning I am unable to leave the hostel before 8.30 or 9. The time that is left after doing my hostel work is hardly sufficient for me to reach back home, take food and return in time to the Presidency College. My second visit to the hostel is generally between 4.30 and 6 P.M. I vary the time of this visit to suit my convenience. Often I have to go home straight from the College and then return to the hostel.

2. Regarding my work as officer ~~in~~ in the U.T.C. the amount of travelling varies according to the number of parades in the week. It also varies from month to month. When the men have their yearly short and long range training, I have to be present at the range every day for several days together. I have to attend all Battalion parades usually held on Saturday mornings at the Fort as also the parades for recruits held twice a week in the evening in the college grounds.

3. It will thus be seen that my work as Dy. Warden and as U.T.C. officer necessitates arduous cycling of not less than 12 to 15 miles a day. Often it is more.

I therefore request that the conveyance of loan of Rs.1000 may be granted.

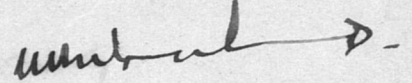
