In G.O.No.165 Law Education Department sanctioning subsidies for the 4th quarter of 24-25 a sum of Rs.1,708/- has been deducted from the current year's grant as savings of the previous years. Of which Rs.996/- represent subsidy granted to the night schools and Rs.712/- the savings of the Government Girls' school.

As the night schools were abolished the sum of Rs.996/- the savings of night schools is a reasonable deduction.



As regards the sum of Rs.712/- relating to the Government Girls' school, it may not be out of place here to mention that it will be seen from the revised budget of this - Municipality, a provision of Rs.1,200/- has been made including the savings of Rs.712/- for the purchase of furniture for the Government Girls' school to replace the old and unserviceable furniture, which were sold in public auction. Accordingly, necessary furniture have been supplied and the cost paid.

The Director of Public Instruction has been addressed by me stating the above facts for consideration and to sanction the amount of Rs.712/- with-held in the above G.O. He in his reply dated 18-2-25 in L.Dis No.386 /B / 25 has informed that the savings have been ordered to be deducted under the orders of the Government.

Under the circumstances, stated above, I have the honour to request that the Government may be graciously pleased to sanction the payment of Rs.712/- being the amount with-held in G.O. No.165 dated 5-2-25, Law Education Department, so as to enable the Municipality to meet the cost of furniture supplied already to the Government Girls' school now under the management of this Municipality.

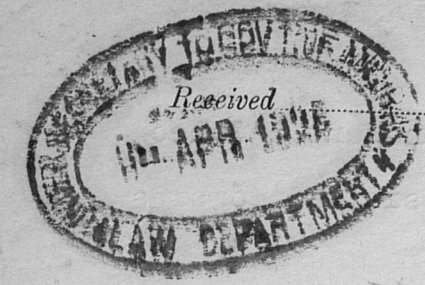
