Report on the Audit of the Elementary Education Fund Accounts of the Tiruvannamalai Municipality, by Mr. J.M. Hooper, Examiner of Local Fund Accounts, for the period extending from 1st April 1923 to 31st March 1924.

The audit of the accounts for the period 1st April 1923 to 31st December 1923 was commenced on 7th March 1924 and ended on the 21st March 1924, was conducted by District Assistant Inspector Mr. M.R. Gopala Ayyar and that for the 4th quarter was commenced on 11th July 1924 and ended on 31st July 1924 in accordance with the rules on the subject.

2. During the period under audit, the office of the Chairman was held by M.R. Ry. T.R. Ramaswami Ayyar Avl., B.A.

3. A note on the defects found in the accounts has been forwarded to the Chairman, Municipal Council. The general result is fairly satisfactory.

4. A sum of Rs. 1159/- only was contributed from Municipal Revenues towards the Elementary Education Fund for the year 1922-23 against Rs. 2254/- provided in the Budget approved of in Government Order No. 1508, Law (Education), dated 30th October 1923. The balance of Rs. 1095/- remains therefore to be contributed from Municipal Revenues.

5. A sum of Rs. 900-4-1 was drawn in Voucher No. 732 and paid to the Elementary School Teachers as compensation in lieu of capitation allowance for the year 1922-23. Under Government Order No. 1164, Law (Education), dated 3rd October 1922, compensation for the loss of capitation allowance is payable only with effect from 1st April 1923. It was also clearly stated in Government Order No. 1508, dated 30th October 1923 approving the budget for the year 1923-24, that the allowance or compensation in question earned in 1922-23 and payable in 1923-24 need not be paid. The payment of the
