2. Samples of 'printed' and 'blank' economy labels are placed on the file. The President D.E.C., Madurai, asks to be supplied with 'covers' and no application is made for the supply of economy labels. The correspondence of D.E.Cs will be mostly with managers of aided elementary schools and with the Presidents of local bodies. The covers addressed to R.E.Cs are not likely to be returned to the office of D.E.Cs. It is therefore suggested that there is not much need for the supply of economy labels and that the words 'and printed economy labels' on page 1 may be omitted and the draft as thus amended may be issued.

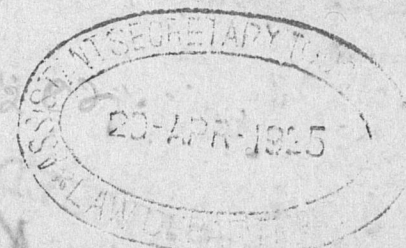
