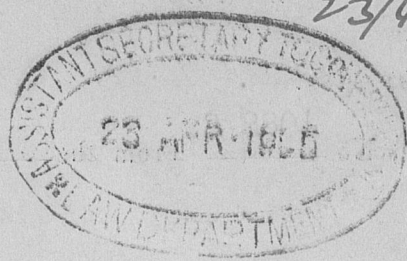

Reference. G.O.No. 605 Law (Education), dated 27-4-1925.

In G.O.No. 386 Law (Education), dated 17-3-1925 it has been stated that the revised rate of remuneration should take effect from the date of the proceedings dated 17-3-1925, but in my subsequent letter R.O.C.No 3646 C/24 dated 30-3-1925 I recommended that the assistant clerk of the college may be given the remuneration from the date of the retirement of the late ~~clerk~~ Head clerk. As the date of effect of the order has not been mentioned in the above G.O. kindly let me know the date from which the order takes effect.

In the letter disposed of in G.O.No. 386 Law (Education), dated 17-3-1925 the Director had asked ^{for} sanction for the acceptance of the remuneration by the Head clerk of the college with effect from the 1st July 1924. The Finance Department objected to the grant of the remuneration with retrospective effect and so ^{the} sanction was allowed to have effect from the date of the proceedings, namely, 17-3-1925. Later on the Director reported

that the former head clerk had retired from service
and the remuneration ^{may} be allowed to the 1st Assistant
clerk of the college with effect from the date of
~~retirement~~ retirement of the former head clerk. This was
sanctioned in G.O. No. 605 Law (Education), dated 27-4-
1925. ^{the} This order is only a modification of G.O. of 17-3-1925.
