I have the honor to inform you that with the
approval of the Council, I have made the following appoint-
ments:-

7 boys' school and 5 girls' schools have already
been opened and 1 Boys' and 1 Girls' school are to be open-
ed this week. It was, therefore, absolutely necessary to
make these appointments.

1) One Supervisor of schools on a salary of Rs
50/- plus an allowance of Rs.15/- from 4-10-24.

2) One Supervisor's peon on Rs.12/- from
16-10-1924.

3) One Vocational female teacher on Rs.

22½ - 1½ - 45 plus an allowance of Rs.10/- from 15-9-24.

4) One Music teacher on Rs.22½ - 1½ - 45

plus an allowance of Rs.10/- from 16-10-24.

5) One Urdu teacher on Rs.20/ from 4-9-24.

As no provision has been made in the Elementary Education Budget, I beg to request that Government may be pleased to sanction the appointments. Funds are available.

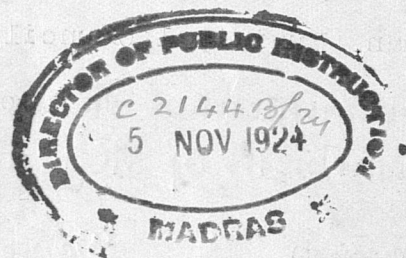

In resubmitting herewith letter D.No.7366/24 dated 27-10-24 of the Chairman, Municipal Council, Cochin referred to me for remarks in Government Endorsement No.4020 A-1 dated 4-11-24, I have the honour to recommend the council's proposal. It has been ascertained that the council intends to impart instruction in lace making in girls schools. The council may be advised to obtain the permission of the District Educational Council in regard to the introduction of vocational education with reference to note (5) to clause (b) of the rules framed under Section 3(v) of the Madras Elementary Education Act of 1920. But the appointment

appointment of a "vocational" female teacher may be tentative, so that we may see whether it is justified by results.

2. The cost of the proposals is to be met from the elementary education fund. It is observed that the Budget Estimate for 1924-25 of the Elementary Education fund as approved in G.O.No.1154 Law (Education) dated 15-7-24 will close with a balance of Rs.5893.

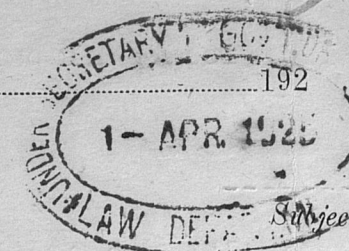

to the District Educational Officer, Malabar No. 1808/25
dated 6th March 1925.

Referring to your R.O.C.No. 174/25 of the 24th February 1925
I have the honour to inform you that the moplas of the locality
are not in favour of Urdu and are strongly for Arabic. If
therefore Arabic is taken in the schools instead of Urdu
these is calculated to have a larger rally of children, and
as such the change is strongly recommended.

In G.O.No. 845 Law (Education) department, dated ~~at~~
~~on~~ 20th June 1923, sanction was accorded to the intro-
duction of compulsory elementary education in the
Cochin Municipality. In recommending its introduc-
tion, ~~the~~ the D.P.I. stated that ~~the~~ the opening of
4 additional schools for boys and five for girls would
be necessary. The Director ^{also} recommended the employ-
ment of a Superintendent on Rs. 50 a month. The --
Chairman, Municipal Council, now reports that ^{will} 8 boys'
schools and 6 girls' schools have been opened ^{in the} ~~for the~~
~~municipality~~ ^{purpose.} He also requests sanction to the employment
of the additional staff mentioned in his letter on
pages 3 and 4 c.f. From the budget estimate of the
Elementary Education fund under the control of the
Council for 1925-26, it appears that the establish-
ments in question have already been entertained. Pro-
vision to meet their salary in 1925-26 has also been
made in the budget. Under section 70 of the District
Municipalities Act, the Municipal Council is itself
competent to sanction the establishments without refe-
rence to any superior authority.

2. A draft order is submitted for approval.
