Sir,

I have the honour to state that, though every facility was afforded for admission of panchamas in the existing elementary schools of this municipality wherein caste people are reading, there is no likelihood of panchama boys seeking admission in them at all. This town consists of several panchama colonies aggregating in all to the extent of 1587 panchamas according to the last census who are mostly illiterates.

terates. The genuineness of the above figure can be assumed to be more imaginary than real because of their frequent visits to the northern parts with families to work in tanneries and to the Kolar Gold Mines. Owing to the existence of the several tanneries, their population is generally great in this town and to uplift this community, an elementary educational institution is an urgent necessity.

2. At present there are two schools for the benefit of the panchama boys, known as M.E.L.M. school located in Pudur High road near railway crossing and a night school in Govindapuram paracherry. The panchama colonies generally situate on the outskirts of the town and the two schools mentioned above will only satisfy the needs of one or two colonies nearer to them at one end of the town. There are also other colonies at the other ends and the boys cannot afford to go a long distance provided arrangements are not made near their localities.

3. In view of the great interest which the Government is taking especially for the uplift of this depressed community, the council at its budget meeting held on the 6th February 1925 unanimously decided to open a panchama school at a cost of Rs.180/- per year at first from municipal fund and to request the Government to meet the entire cost from Provincial funds as their financial position is not sound for its continuance from their funds in view of the heavy charges incurable in the various administrative functions of this municipality.

4. Under the circumstances, I request the Government will be pleased to sanction a sum of Rs.180/-, the details of which are given in the margin, to open an elementary school from 1st April 1925 for the benefit of the panchama boys of this municipality at an early date.

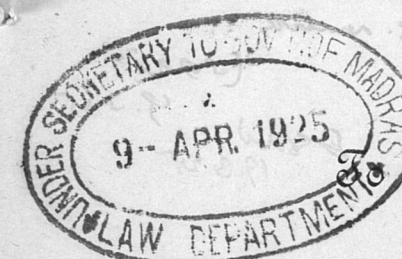

In view of this fact it is not understood how the progress of Adi-Dravida education can be advanced by the opening of a separate school.

3. Further, Government in para 2 of their order No. Mis. 1538, Law (Education) dated 3rd November 1923 have deprecated the opening of special schools for Adi-Dravidas.
