From the printed list of demands it appears that the object of the mover is "to raise the question of training ⁱⁿ non-Government schools." Apparently he would that ^{training} should be attached to non-Government schools. If it be so, it has only to be pointed out that this

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a ^{which has been accepted} is/policy/already/adopted by Government. One of the recommendations of the Retrenchment Committee was to attach training classes to ordinary schools. This system is ^{now} in force in the following schools:-

Noble College, Masulipatam.
P.R. College, Codanada.
S. P. G. High School, Nandyal.
Tirupati High School, Ambasamudram.
R. C. Training School, Trichinopoly.

In the above case, Government are giving grants to the managements concerned to meet the cost of the training. The D.P.I. has been asked to ~~introduce this~~ ~~wherever possible~~ consider the question of extending this system wherever possible.
