Sir,

In continuation of this Department letter No. 1409, dated  
the 30th November 1923, I am directed to communicate the follow-  
ing resolution adopted by the Fifth Assembly of the League of  
Nations on the 23rd September 1924:-

"The Assembly:

Being convinced of the fundamental importance of familiaris-  
ing young people throughout the world with the principles and  
work of the League of Nations, and of training the younger  
generation to regard international co-operation as the normal  
method of conducting world affairs;

In view of the resolutions adopted by the Fourth Assembly  
regarding the encouragement of contact between young people of  
different nationalities, and concerning the instruction of  
youth in the ideals of the League of Nations;

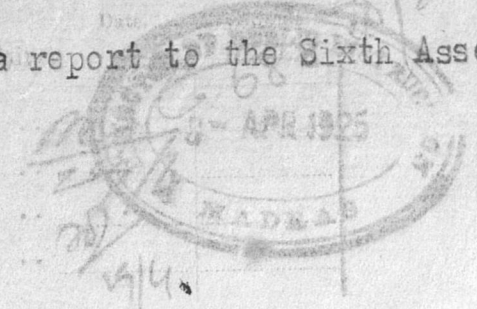
Is of opinion that further steps should be taken to promote  
these objects;

And therefore instructs the Secretariat/<sup>to</sup>investigate the  
means by which efforts to promote contact and to educate the  
youth of all countries in the ideals of world peace and solidari-  
ty may be further developed and co-ordinated, and to furnish

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a report to the Sixth Assembly".

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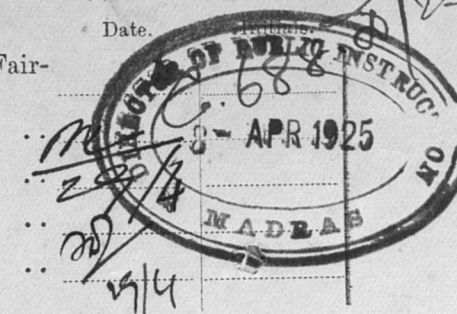
