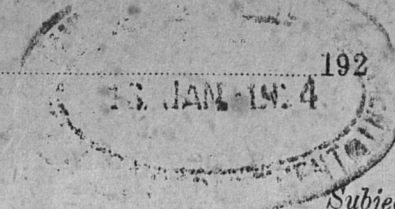

3. Instruction is proposed to be given to about 25 pupils in weaving in batches of 5 at a time each batch receiving 1 full half day's instruction per week.

4. Mr.Porrett who examined the scheme estimates the recurring and non-recurring charges of the weaving class at Rs.580 and Rs.920 as per details noted in the margin.

5. It is proposed to put up a temporary building 40' x 20' in the school compound for accommodating the weaving class at an approximate cost of Rs.350/-.

6. The management is prepared to bear one half of the recurring and non-recurring charges involved in the scheme and request that the other half may be borne by Government.

7. I submit herewith a re-appropriation statement for meeting the expenditure during the 2 months of the current year.

I request also that the necessary provision may be inserted in the Budget Estimate for 1924-25.

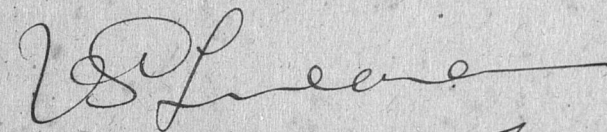

The reappropriation statement submitted by the S.P.D. provides for two months' charges ^(in the current year) the scheme may, if it is submitted, be sanctioned with effect from the 15th February next and ~~for~~ a recurring grant given only for 15 days in the current year. The total grant, recurring and non-recurring, admissible to the management will then amount to Rs 472 ^{if} instead of Rs 508. The reappropriation statement has accordingly been amended.

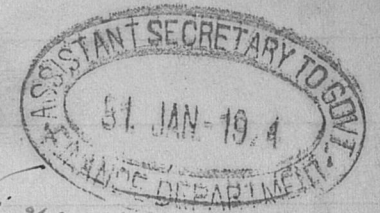
The figures given in para 2 of Law (E.M.) note on p. 1 ante are not correct. According to the reappropriation statements recently submitted by the D.P.I., a sum of ~~1.08~~ 1.08 lakhs has been utilised out of the balance of the lump provision of 1.15 lakhs on account of schemes for 'Vocational Education' sanctioned up to the 1st week of Jan. 1924 and as further schemes have since been sanctioned it appears likely that the budget provision will have been fully utilised. The Law (E.M.) dept. may therefore be requested to report in consultation with the D.P.I., if necessary, whether funds will ~~be~~ be available to meet the expenditure in the current year on the schemes now under consideration.

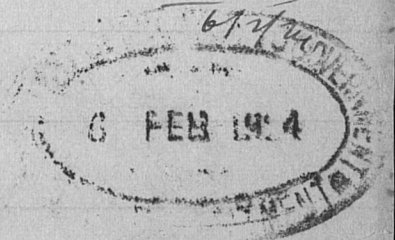

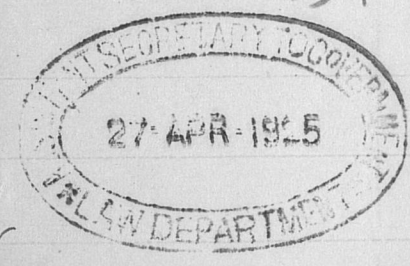
