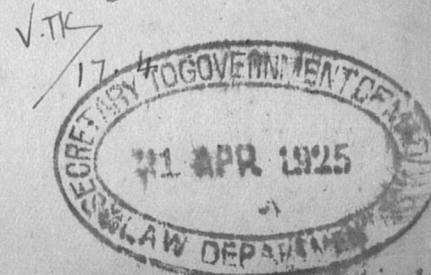

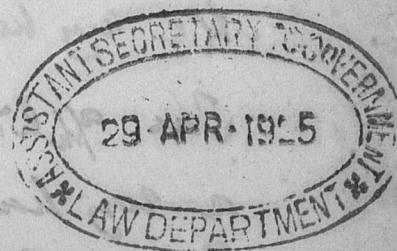
My dear Sir,
