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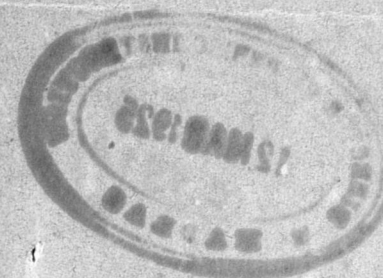

Sir, through the Director of Public Instruction, Madras.

I have the honour to report that on account of Plague and consequent evacuation of the town, the Board Middle School at Kaveripatnam had to be closed temporarily for a period of 5 weeks from 19-1-25 to 3-2-25 and from 12-3-25 to 4-3-25 on the advice of the District Health Officer, Salem.

2. The collection of school fees for the short term of the school year has therefore to be made with reference to the period of actual working of the school in this term.

3. I have accordingly issued a memo to the Headmaster, Kaveripatnam Middle School to collect the school fees within five days from the re-opening of the school after its temporary closure

on account of plague. A copy of the memo is enclosed for kind reference.

4. I request that my action in having relaxed Rule 86(1) of the revised Madras Educational Rules under the circumstances explained above may be kindly approved.

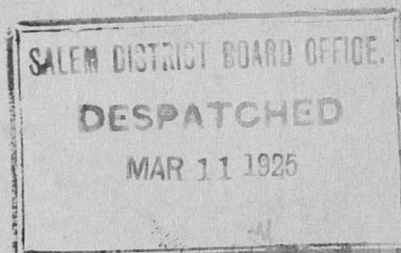

As the school had to be closed owing to outbreak of plague, the fees for the current term have not been collected in monthly instalments as they become due.

2. As soon as the school re-opens, please arrange to collect the arrear fees within the prescribed five days after the date of re-opening, in accordance with the Educational Rules.

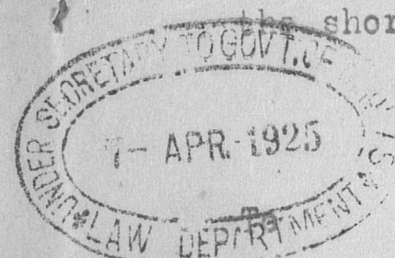

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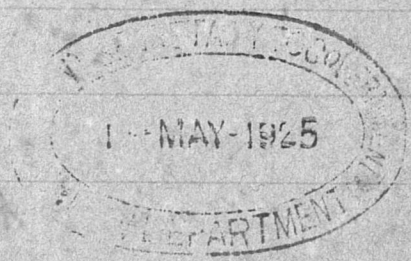
