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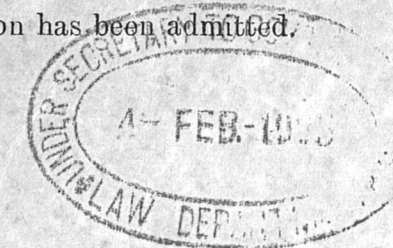

In elementary schools, there is no necessity for separate Urdu munshis. ~~perhaps in schools~~ ^{perhaps in schools} or mainly intended for Muhammadans ~~in which case~~ all or most of the teachers employed would ordinarily have sufficient knowledge of Urdu.
