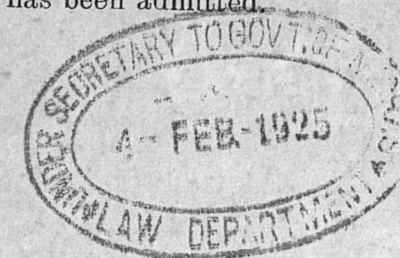

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The Retrenchment Committee recommended that sessional schools for masters should be abolished or that the expenditure thereon should no longer be borne by Government. The D.P.I. agreed to ^{the} abolition of the sessional schools excepting those intended solely for members of the backward classes.

2. The inspecting officers of the department reported that the Hindustani sessional school at Trichinopoly had outrun its purpose (page 5 of G.O.No. 1482, dated 19-9-24) and the District Board has accordingly resolved to close the school with effect from 1-4-25 (G.O.No.1918, dated 8-12-24)

Mr. MUHAMMAD GHOUSE MIAN SAHIB:—"Arising out of the answer to the question, was it on the recommendation of the district board that the school was closed and the grant made by the Government was stopped or did the Government stop the grant themselves?"

The hon. Rao Bahadur Sir A. P. PATRO:—"The district board resolved to close the school. The Government did not stop the grant."
