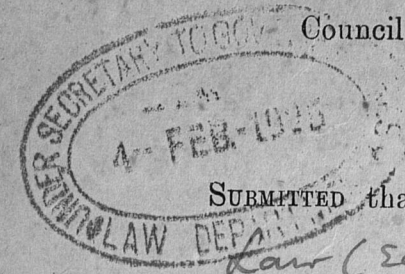

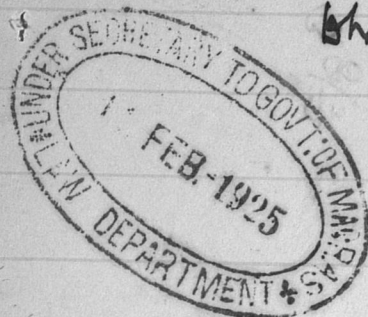

Some of the D.E.Os have submitted their detailed reports. These do not include suggestions for the opening of any new schools for special classes or communities. As will be seen from para 1 of Government Memo No. 3336 A-2 dated 9th September 1924 [and the resolutions of the Elementary Education Conference therein referred to] the object of the present operations is to provide at least one school in each village with a population of 500 and over. Consequently it is impracticable to open simultaneously schools for special classes.
