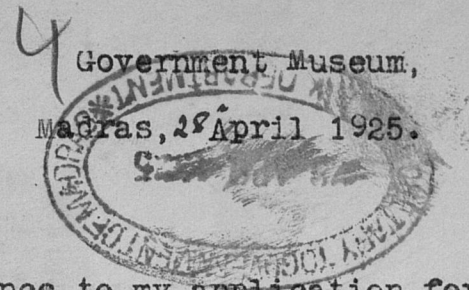

2. The Supdt, suggests that his Personal
Assistant, Mr. Raghavan, may be appointed to offi-
ciate in his place and that he may be given a pay
of Rs.300 during the period, in view of the assump-
tion^{by him} of duties of greater responsibility and
importance. The pay of the Supdt, is Rs.500-50-1000
and one appointed to act in his place will in the
ordinary course draw the minimum pay of Rs 500.
Under Rule 35 of the Fundamental Rules it is open
to the local Government to fix the pay at an amount
less than this and it is under this rule that a
pay of Rs 300 is suggested by the Supdt, in this
case.

on a former occasion the permanent Supdt, ~~WERN~~ went
on leave for six weeks, his personal assistant was
asked to hold charge of the ^{current duties of the} office and he was given
a charge allowance of Rs 50. If a similar arrange-
ment is made on the present occasion, Mr. Raghavan
can, under subsidiary rule 2 to Fundamental rules
49, be paid an additional pay of Rs 19 (1/10th of
his own substantive pay of Rs 192). This is appa-

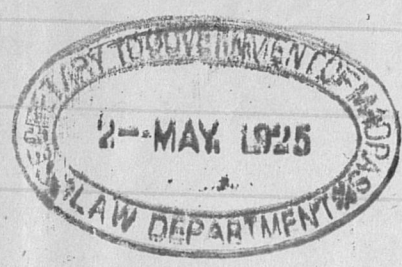

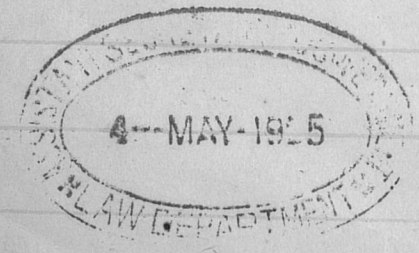
