Mr. Veerian suggested to the Hon'ble the Minister for Education that in the case of depressed classes, certificates of poverty given by the members of Taluk Boards and Municipal Councils, Presidents and Members of Union Boards and Presidents of Panchayat Courts should be admitted in granting the concession of school fees. The Government have declined to admit certificates given by the members of local bodies. The Hon'ble Minister is inclined to consider the question of allowing the certificates in the case of depressed classes alone. The D.P.I. may be asked to state whether he sees any objection to this course.

Mr. Veerian's proposal seems unnecessary, but if it is desired to offer further facilities to members of the depressed classes to secure certificates I should have thought the most suitable person to include in Rule 92 of the M.E.R. would be the Labour Officer. I understand that there is in each district such an officer and that he is expected to know all about the depressed classes in his district. 2. It will be observed that the additional certifying authorities now proposed are only for depressed classes. There is at present no authorized list of depressed classes and it may not be appropriate to issue the proposed rule immediately. There is however a proposal to continue to Indian Christian pupils of depressed classes origin the educational concessions which they would have secured if they had not become Christians, and in that connection it has been suggested that the present list of backward - classes should virtually be split up into two - - one comprising the depressed classes and the other the non-depressed yet backward in point of literacy. It is for consideration whether the issue of the draft in this case ~~may~~ need not be held over till it is clearly defined which of the depressed classes should

be reckoned as backward for purposes of fee concessions. This definition when published will regulate the application of the go. The draft may in the meanwhile be sent to Law (General) & L.S. G. w/o for acceptance.

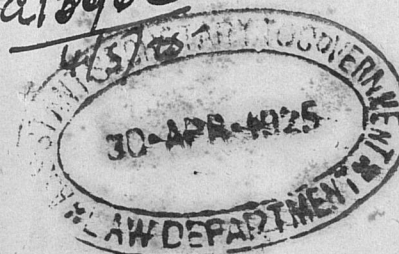
