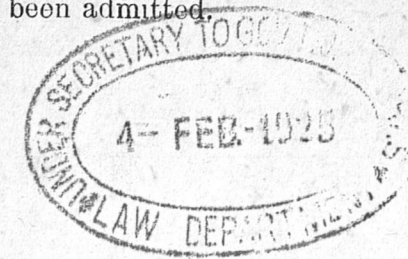

The Hon'ble Member apparently refers to the suggestion ~~which was~~ made to the Secondary Education Reorganization Committee, which aimed at decentralizing the work of the Secondary School-leaving Certificate Boards to enable it to divide itself into Committees with jurisdiction over particular areas and with power to conduct examinations in those areas. The Committee, however, considered that any such decentralization scheme would, in actual working, be too complex and lead to an unnecessary degree of divergent standard.

* 436 Q.—MR. MUHAMMAD GHOUSE MIAN SAHIB: Will the hon. the Minister for Education be pleased to state whether the Government have in contemplation a division of this Province into four linguistic areas for purposes of Secondary School-Leaving Certificate Examination with different standards of efficiency according to the aforesaid linguistic areas?

A.—The Educational Reorganization Committee recommended against it.

MR. MUHAMMAD GHOUSE MIAN SAHIB:—"May I know the reason why the Committee recommended against it?"

THE HON. RAO BAHADUR SIR A. P. PATRO:—"When the report is published, I shall be glad to furnish a copy of the report to the hon. Member."

SRIMAN BISWANATH DAS MAHASAYO:—"May I know the names and the extent of the four linguistic areas?"

THE HON. RAO BAHADUR SIR A. P. PATRO:—"That is not the question, Sir."

SRIMAN BISWANATH DAS MAHASAYO:—"Question 436 asks whether the Province is going to be divided into four linguistic areas for purposes of Secondary School-Leaving Certificate Examination and the answer says that the Educational Reorganization Committee recommended against it. I want to know, Sir, from the Government the names and the jurisdiction of these four linguistic areas which are recommended against by the Educational Reorganization Committee?"

THE HON. RAO BAHADUR SIR A. P. PATRO:—"They did not specify the areas but they only gave the number of linguistic areas."

MR. MUHAMMAD GHOUSE MIAN SAHIB:—"What is the opinion of the hon. the Minister for Education in the matter?"
