to Scientific Societies by Rs 1,000.

The allotment of Rs. 2,000 is composed of
the following items:-

(i) Grant of Rs. 1,000 to the Bhandarkar
Oriental Research Institute, Poona.

(ii) Grant to the Fine Arts Society, Madras

Item (i) above.

In G.O. No. 1465 Law (Education), dated
4-10-1921 the Government sanctioned an annual grant of
Rs. 1,000 to the Bhandarkar Oriental Research Institute
which is bringing out a scientific and critical edition
of the Mahabharata. The grant is to be continued till
the work is finished and is payable ^{each year} on receipt of
a report of satisfactory progress. The Govt. have
already paid four instalments of the grants and fifth
instalment is provided for in the next year's budget.
The Retrenchment Committee recommended that this grant
be discontinued. ^{The Hon. the Minister} His Excellency the Governor, declined
to accept the recommendation of the committee on the
ground that the work of the society deserved encourage-

Item (ii) above.

The Grant to the Fine Arts Society is an old one.
The Society used to receive ^{an annual} the grant from the Govt.
for some years prior to 1895. In that year the
Society appears to have ceased to exist. The Society

was revived in 1898 and the grant ~~was also~~ that it
had been in receipt of ^{previously} was also revived from 1899-1900.
The grant is to encourage fine arts and is apparently to
meet a portion of the expenses of the annual exhibition
conducted by the society.

2. The Hon'ble member will apparently urge ^{that} some-
thing more ~~substantial~~ substantial should be done by Government
to encourage fine arts and scientific research. Any
useful suggestion which the Member might make may be
heard and consideration promised.
