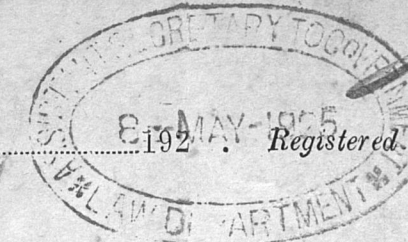

Sir,

I have the honour to submit for the orders of Government and for such action as they may deem fit the following case of illegal detention in the Government Junior Certified School, Ranipet, caused by the Bezwada Railway Police who escorted certain boys to the Junior Certified School at Ranipet.

2. In his order dated 11th April 1925 the Sub Divisional, 1st Class Magistrate ^{Bezwada} committed under Sec. 29 (3) (1) of the Madras Children Act 1920, the marginally noted boys, to the Junior Certified School at Ranipet, to be detained ^{there} until they attained the age of 16 years. It

would appear that these boys
were ordered to be escorted
to Ranipet by the Bezwada
Railway Police. On their way

to Ranipet one of the boys
No. (3) Tota Sangaiah appears

to have escaped from the Police custody. The escape is
reported to have taken place in Madras and the Police
escorts seem to have picked up a different boy named
Abdul Gani in Madras and substituted him for the one that
is escaped. The 10 boys, including one that was substituted,
were taken to the Government Junior Certified School, Ranipet
and handed over to the Superintendent of ^{the} School who admitted
them on 13-4-25. The boy picked up in Madras and substitu-
ted for the one that escaped, is reported to have been in-
structed by the Police escorts to personate the boy that
escaped, on admission into the School. The Superintendent
of the School was not therefore aware of the real facts.
The ~~truth~~ truth was however, discovered by him at
the time when he made arrangements for the celebration
of the Ramzan festival and it has been confirmed by the
remaining 9 boys from Bezwada. The matter has been brought
to the notice of the Commissioner of Railway Police, Madras
by the Superintendent of the School.

3. As it is a case of illegal detention I request the
favour of very early orders as regards the discharge of the
pupil who has been illegally detained.

4. I beg to inform Government in this connection that
the boy ^{No 7} Abdul Gani mentioned in the Sub Divisional Magis-
trate's order is a different Muhammadan boy from the one
picked up in Madras.

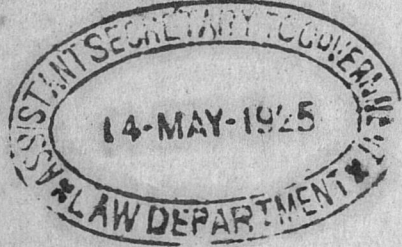

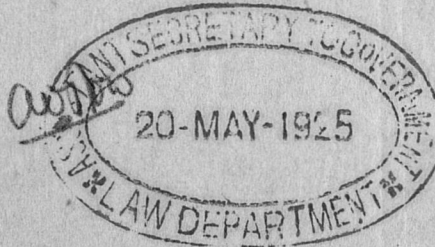
