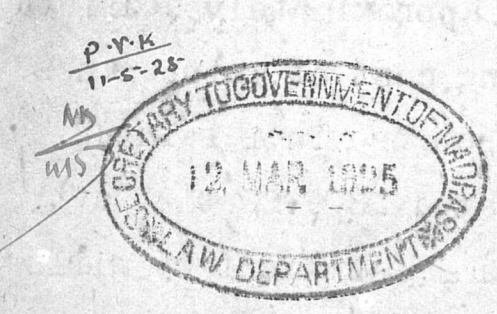

In his letter No.434-C, dated 4-5-22 printed in
G.O.No.1132 dated 23-9-22, the D.P.I proposed the
transfer to the control of local bodies of a -
number of Govt.elementary schools for girls, -
excepting ~~the~~ ^{two} model schools ~~attached~~ to Govt.
training institutions and such of the girls' school
as were likely to develop into secondary schools.
Most of the local bodies agreed to the transfer
of the schools to their control, on condition that
they were given a subsidy approximately equal to
the ~~amount~~ annual recurring cost of maintenance
of the schools incurred from provincial funds.
In G.O.No.1132 Law(Edn), dated 23-9-22, the Govt.
sanctioned the transfer of 150 elementary girls'
schools to the control of local bodies. Subse -
quently, however, some local bodies applied to Govt
for additional subsidies to meet the cost of -
employment of additional teachers in the schools,
or the cost of contributions to the Provident fund
on behalf of the teachers. The Govt.however -

declined to entertain these requests, as, at the time of transfer, there was no undertaking on the part of Govt. to meet the net cost of the schools. Apparently, the Hon'ble Member is ~~is~~ dissatisfied with this decision. If Govt. are to meet the full net cost of the schools transferred, they ^{schools} may as well be taken back under Govt. control. It is not fair that local bodies should desire to have the credit of managing the schools, while the Govt. provide all the necessary funds *for their development in future*
