The notes in G.O.No.1101 Law (Education) dated 8-7-24 give a full account of the reorganisation of the superior inspecting agency which came into force in February 1923. At present, there is a District Educational Officer for each district excepting the Nilgiris. 9 posts are included in the I.E.S. and 15 (12 permanent plus 3 temporary) posts are in the M.E.S. As ^{two} 2 officers of the I.E.S. holding posts of D.E.Os. are on leave, the ^{two} 2 posts held by them are kept in abeyance and ^{two} 2 temporary posts in the M.E.S. have been created. Thus, provision has been made in the budget estimate for 1925-26 for

7 D.E.Os. in the I.E.S.

12 permanent D.E.Os. in the M.E.S.

5 temporary D.E.Os. in the M.E.S.

Having regard to the varied duties of a District Educational Officer as detailed in paragraph 4 of the notes in G.O.No. 1101 dated 8-7-24, it is considered desirable that each district excepting the Nilgiris should have a District Educational Officer. It is not therefore possible to dispense with any of the posts of temporary D.E.Os. It may be mentioned that the whole question of the reorganisation of the superior educational services in the light of the recommendations of the Lee Commission

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will shortly come under the consideration of Government and any suggestions made by Hon'ble Members may be considered in that connection.
